1. CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL AND ESTABLISHMENT OF A QUORUM

The District must file the measure to the Registrar of Voters by Friday August 12, 2022 so the it appears on the November 2022 election Ballot.

The Parcel Report has been requested from the County but will not be updated until July. Per Taussig, the District should use the 2021-2022 numbers as the preliminary rates for planning.

2022- FY 2022-2023 final year of current parcel tax; therefore renewal should be on Nov 2022 general election ballot.
