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Chiefs April Report 2017

- We have hired our new employee Sean Witherall. He has a good background and experience with other agencies in the county. Sean did well in all his interviews and I think he is a good fit for us, as we are for him. He is winding up his training and should begin shift work the second pay period of April.
- 2. I have contacted Richardson Heating and Sheet Metal about a contract for services regarding our HVAC. I have suggested a Bi- Annual service rather than the quarterly that we had with Petersen. This would be more cost effective and give us set dates for inspections and service. I am waiting to hear back.
- 3. Just completed our septic permit for the first half of the year, even after all of the rain our systems are both dry and both are way under the daily gallon/dose allotted on our permits. The next report is due in October.
- 4. Lights where installed over the reception work area making a major improvement in visibility, we will continue in making changes to the Hallway and Dayroom lights. I have not heard anything about the Apparatus Bay lights.
- 5. I still have not heard from Lanning about replacing the roof screws.

Weed whack and spray in and around the areas with ornamental bark Spray in and around other areas as denoted by the Fire Chief Maintain and shape all bushes and plants Remove any non-planted saplings or bushes.

Maintain and shape ivy on water tanks
Mow and spray around oak and redwood trees
Maintain irrigation system
Blow leaves and general outside clean up
